

Library Services during COVID-19 Pandemic Policy

The Marion Public Library Board, the Director, and the staff all recognize that COVID-19 is a worldwide pandemic and is a threat to public health at this time and possibly for many months to come. The Marion Public Library also recognizes the importance of offering service to the public while at the same time maintaining the highest level of safety to the staff and public.

The Marion Public Library will follow the suggested orders and guidelines issued by the Waupaca County Department of Health and Human Services as long as they are in place.

The Marion Public Library will have the flexibility to move back and forth with service phases and guidelines recognizing that conditions may require rapid decision making by state and county authorities.

The Director will take action per orders from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and/or the Waupaca County Department of Health & Human Services regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, recognizing that changes may be instituted.
